CANTEEN NEWS

In a time when we crave definitive answers, it appears there are very few. The Corona Virus has seen to that. It is anybody's guess as to when we will be able to open up the Canteen and the Hall to its full capacity.

Currently, the Bunker Bar is the only bar that is open to our Members and their Guests. We have 5 tables with 4 bar chairs each, for a total of 20 under the roof of the bunker. All tables are socially distanced at 6 feet apart. We have 2 tables on the stage under a tent which seats 8 people. There are four (4) picnic tables that are under two (2) 10 foot by 20 foot tents which can accommodate another 16 Members. Additional picnic tables with umbrellas are arranged 6 feet apart.

LIVE ENTERTAINMENT:

Weather permitting, the Bunker will be having live Bands on Friday and Saturday nights. Check out our Facebook Page and the SOUND OFF for who is playing when.

For the safety of our Members, Guests and Staff we have installed hand sanitizers at the Bunker entrance walkway, 2 in the Bunker Bar entrances and one in each of the porta johns. After checking your Membership Card, our bartenders will check your temperature. We then ask that all Members print their name and the names of their Guests in our book. This will help with tracing if it is ever needed. So far, it has not been needed.

THANK YOU: This July was the hottest July in 125 years. The Bar Committee would like to thank our Bartenders, Warren, Robin, Lori, Danielle and Shea for braving the heat to serve our Members

with refreshing beverages. We would also like to thank our Members who visited the Bunker during this time, since this is the Post's only source of income.

FOOD: Ryan's catering serves food from Tuesday thru Sunday (no Mondays) from noon to 7PM. So, stop by to eat, drink and be merry.

OTHER THANK YOU'S: We have NO community service people and NO Corrections Inmates to help clean the bathrooms and the Bunker, take out the garbage, maintain the grounds, put up and take down the tents, change kegs, replace ice, change beer gas, and stock can beer.

The Magic Wand of Cinderella's Fairy Godmother was borrowed by a Member, and we have been unable to get it back. Because of this, the following Members should be acknowledged for stepping up and doing the jobs that need to be done every day: Commander Ed Rutzler, Bob Joerg, John Holterman, Dale Harpe, Vice Commander Pete Chafatelli, SAL Commander Rocky Lucia, SAL Vice Commander Mel Avallo and State Vice Commander Rich Godfrey. One

of the backbones of the Post, Phil (PJ) Jones, continues to come in and open-up the Post every day at around 7AM.

A Thank You to SAL Treasurer Pete Coleman and Joe Steff for completing the stainless-steel drains and drainage systems for the taps in the Canteen.

The Bar Committee would also like to thank all the Members that signed up on Vice Commander Pete Chafatelli's list to check in Members at the Bunker.

In anticipation of a partial inside opening, the Bar Committee has devised 25% and 50% seating capacity plans. Full Capacity in the Bar is 100 people. Full Capacity in the Hall is 225 people.

Once seating capacity is met in the Canteen, other Members and their Guests will be directed to the Hall. There will be a full-service bar, TV's and waitress service, just like the Canteen. **NO ONE WILL BE TURNED AWAY.**

BUNKER NEWS: The peace accord with the varmints is still holding. At a recent sit down with the Commander Ed Rutzler, Squirrel Commander "Rocky" no-





ticed through aerial surveillance that not all Human Members were social distancing.

COVID 19 **Warnings About** **Additional Income**

So you have been receiving additional stimulus monies from the government. It is really nice when your bonus money comes in. Don't you wish it would continue? While the additional monies are good for the individual household and for the economy, have you considered what the tax consequences will be for you come 2021?

The additional \$600 per week that went out to folks on unemployment will be considered additional income, by the IRS. And since no taxes were deducted the recipient of the additional funds will be required to pay the tax on that money when they pay their income taxes next year. So if you were one of the many who received the additional \$600 per week unemployment, be aware of your tax liability.

The \$1200 check that most of us received from the CARES act will not be considered income and there will not be any taxes due on that money. Let's say you received the credit based on your 2018/2019 income and you no longer qualify for it in 2020, the IRS will not make you pay it back. Conversely if your income level changes and you now qualify for more, you will receive that with your tax return.

Please check with your accountant.

Our Post Finances

As you know, our post has been all but closed since

March. We were able to defer our mortgage payment for three months but that deferment has expired and we are now back paying the mortgage and the interest that has accumulated. Our revenue is solely derived from the bunker bar and a limited amount of pull tabs. There is no bingo and no weddings and the canteen remains closed by the order of the governor.

This is the perfect storm for our Post. The bills continue to need to be paid but the revenue

has virtually come to a standstill. The monies that we had put away, for times like these, will sustain us for a while but not forever. Your Commander and the rest of the financial team are busy planning for an extended shutdown and will report back to you when the plan is ready.
